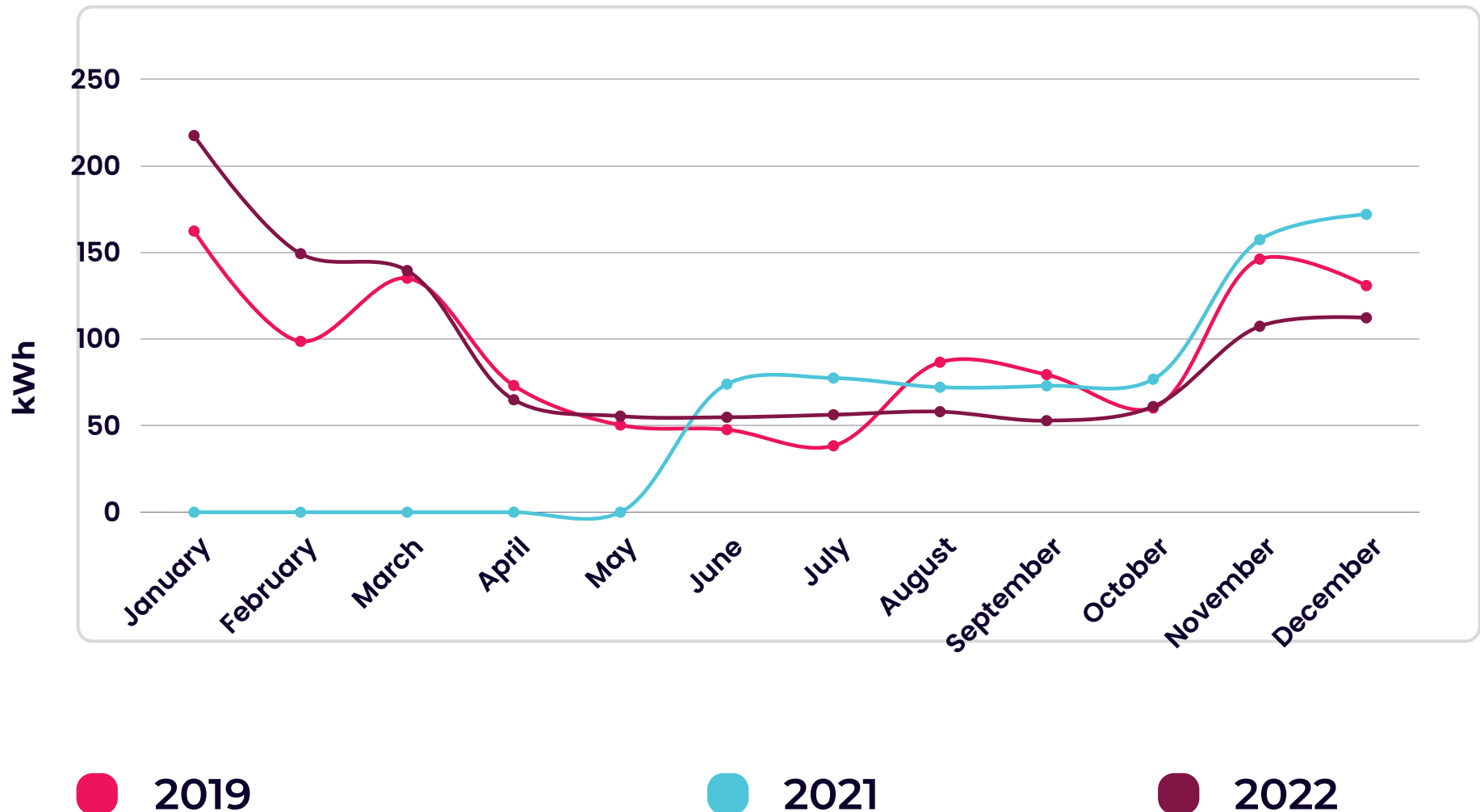

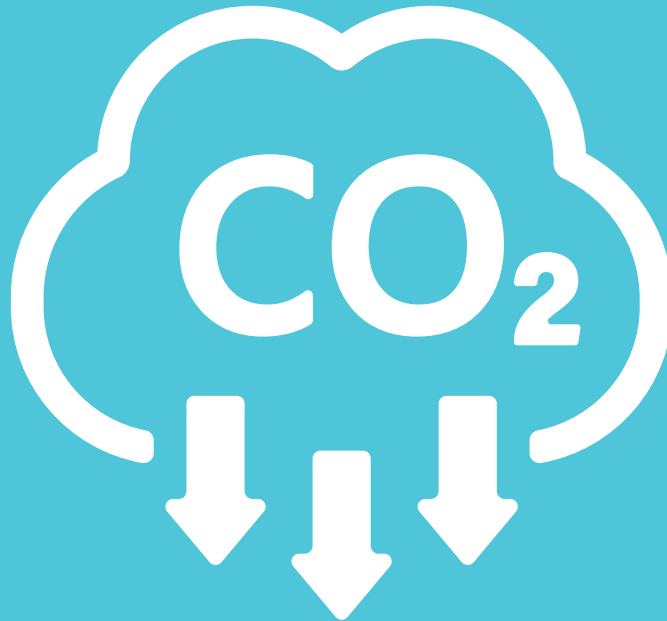

Reduced boiler thermostats

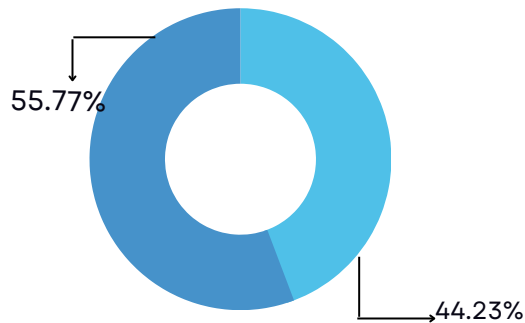
LED lighting throughout the hotel with sensors in less frequently used areas

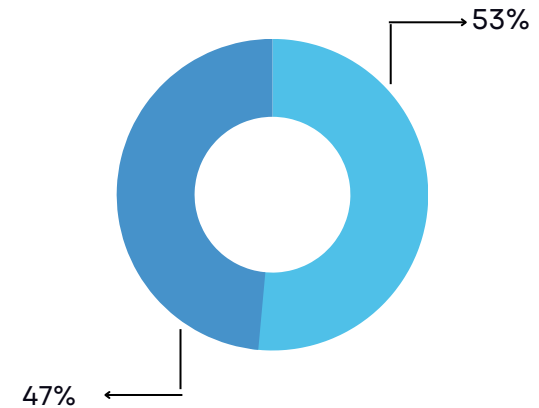

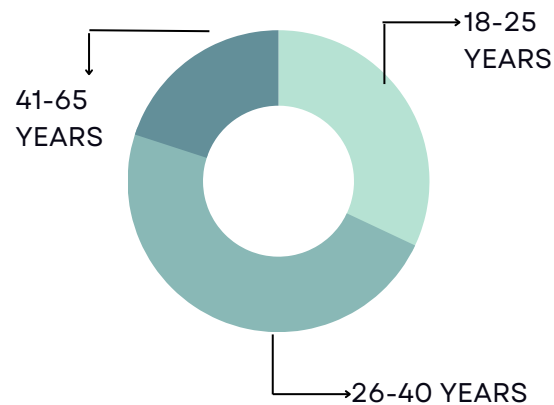

We took important steps to further incorporate sustainability into The Killarney Parks operations. This included launching the TRKPH Advisory Council which is made up of staff and management. The council ensures that People, Planet & Profit are considered in all aspects of hotel operations.
